On the main issues, how do Guildford's contenders compare?

On Crime:

Conservatives

We believe in personal responsibility, and respect for law abiding citizens

We will:

- Clamp down on Antisocial Behaviour
- Put 60 more police on the beat in Guildford

Lib Dems

Will abolish the mandatory life sentence for murder (Lib Dem Policy Paper No 51 "Justice in the Community" June 2002 p42)

Will reduce the drinking age to 16 (Lib Dem spokesman in Parliament Hansard 25 Jan 2005 Col 185)

Will Legalise cannabis (Lib Dem Policy Paper 10, January 2005)

On tax:

We believe in lower taxes to reward hard work and let people make their own choices

We will:

- Cut Council Tax for the over 65s by £500 or 50%
- Increase tax relief on pension savings for standard rate taxpayers

Lib Dems believe in higher taxes. 'Our slogan at the next election will be "Trust us, we will put your taxes up"' (Andrew George on Radio 5 Live, *Simon Mayo Show*, 19 January 2005).

They will introduce a Local Income Tax which they admit will cost more than Council Tax if you earn £40,000 and live in a band D house

On planning:

We believe in local decision-making
We will let local councils decide how many new houses Surrey can take

The remote Regional "Assembly" will take the key decisions about our countryside
