- **Pirbright** Road Safety scheme now in design phase, with a view to the scheme being implemented next year.

- Road and pavement resurfacing has been approved for Bramble
 Close Guildford, Beech Lane
 Normandy, Mill Lane (part)
 Pirbright, Oak Hill footpath Wood
 Street Village.
- Planning Keith has supported residents to limit operations of Gunners in Worplesdon, and 20-20 Recycling in Normandy. He also supported GBC proposals to remove the illegal Whipley Farm buildings and return the land to green belt.

NORMANDY FLOOD FORUM ESTABLISHED

Keith Witham proposed the formation of a Normandy Flood Forum.

This will bring residents and authorities together to find solutions for local flooding problems.

It will examine all areas of the Village affected by flooding and particularly the Westward Lane—Beech Lane—Christmas Pie area and the Glaziers Lane area.

Keith said: "Normandy is often badly hit by floods.

I hope that the new Normandy Flood Forum will bring together local knowledge and expert knowledge to find the right solutions to the problem, just as the Worplesdon and Pirbright Flood Forums have done."

WYKE PRIMARY SCHOOL Road safety improvements

Before he was elected last year, Keith said he would support parents at the Wyke Primary School and campaign for improved road safety measures at the junction of School Lane and Aldershot Road, where children and parents cross the road.

During 2012 he successfully obtained the installation of flashing school signs at the junction, plus funding to get

red road surfacing and an improved pedestrian refuge.

Keith is also pressing for a School Crossing Patrol at the location.
