Through determined action, the two worst roads in Guildford South East Division, Tormead Road and East Shalford Lane, will be resurfaced amongst other roads, including Abbotswood, Sydney Road, Denmark Road, North Street, Chertsey Street and Market Street. I will work hard to have more roads in our area resurfaced.
